First Time Felony Diversion Program	District Attorney, Adult Probation
External Change Lever within Dept./County SOI	External Partners (potential collaborative partners)

2. **Statement:** DA's Office and Adult Probation develop a Felony Diversion program to reduce adult First Time Felony Convictions

Increase the Attainment of Postsecondary Credentials w/ Significant Labor Market Value (20-30)

External Change Lever within Dept./County SOI	External Partners (potential collaborative partners)
Community College Sectoral Employment Program	Community Colleges, Private Employers

2. **Statement:** WDACS and DHR partner with Community College and Private Employers to create a Community College Sectoral Employment Program to Increase Attainment of Postsecondary Credentials with significant labor market value



Brainstorm Initiative Kernel Statements

Guidance for creating Kernel Statements

1. Indicate what North Star(s) **OR** Contributing Outcome(s) the initiative will aim to influence

- 2. One change lever per kernel statement
- 3. Brainstorm at least one "Big Bet" (a substantial undertaking with the potential for significant impact)
- 4. You don't have to know whether a department would be committed to an initiative to propose their attachment to an idea (When in doubt, leave it in. Don't overthink it.)
