In celebration of Juneteenth 2024 and as a representation of the commitment to the work of reparations, the County of Los Angeles (County) will provide free admission and access to participating museums and beaches on or around June 19, 2024, for eligible LA County residents who are lineal descendants of African-American Chattel enslaved persons or free African-American persons living in the United States prior to the end of the 19th Century (“Community of Eligibility Residents”).
