Ivan Sulic was born and raised in San Pedro, California, and is currently a resident of the City of Downey. He serves as the Senior Deputy to Los Angeles County Supervisor Janice Hahn, representing the communities of Downey, La Mirada, Norwalk, Whittier, Santa Fe Springs, and the unincorporated communities of North Whittier, South Whittier, East Whittier, West Whittier, and Los Nietos.

As Supervisor Hahn's Homeless and Housing Deputy, Ivan serves as the primary liaison to the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA) and the Los Angeles County Department of Homeless Services and Housing. He also serves as the Supervisor's Alternate on the Los Angeles County Affordable Housing Solutions Agency (LACAHS) Board of Directors. He oversees the implementation of homelessness programs and housing initiatives funded through Measure H, Measure A, and state and federal resources throughout the Fourth Supervisorial District. He has played a key role in advancing projects that expand access to housing, supportive services, and community resources for vulnerable residents.

Among his notable accomplishments, Ivan was instrumental in the creation of the Whittier LGBTQ+ Community Center, which provides medical care, mental health services, workforce development, and other essential resources to the community. A passionate advocate for the LGBTQ+ community, he has also been actively involved in the planning and organization of Downey Pride since its inception, helping establish the annual celebration as an important event that recognizes and supports the City's LGBTQ+ community and its allies.

A dedicated advocate for environmental conservation, Ivan has long championed the preservation of open space and native habitats. He serves on the Wildlife Corridor Conservation Authority and is Chairman of the Puente Hills Habitat Preservation Authority, which oversees more than 4,000 acres of protected open space and trail systems throughout the Whittier Hills. He also serves as Chairman of the Southeast Social Services Funding Authority, helping guide regional investments in senior services and workforce development programs.

Ivan has dedicated more than a decade to public service. He began his career in 2010 in the office of U.S. Congresswoman Jane Harman before joining the office of Janice Hahn when she served in the U.S. Congress, where he was Deputy District Director and Military Affairs Liaison. He has also served his community as a member of the San Pedro and Wilmington Neighborhood Councils, demonstrating his longstanding commitment to civic engagement and public service.
