The Marin City Stormwater Plan is a drainage study aimed at reducing flood risk in Marin City. The plan seeks to address existing flooding conditions and identify potential solutions that enhance flood resilience in Marin City while accounting for community priorities.

Community engagement and meetings have been a priority, and this is the third and final community meeting. This informational update will include recommended flood improvements for Marin City in 2025 and beyond.



Pump Beautification

Discussion

Following the Community Meeting #3 open house, Marin City Arts & Culture will lead a presentation related to beautification of the proposed Marin City Flood Improvement Gateway Pump Station. The pump station improvement concept is one component of the Stormwater Plan.

The purpose of this presentation is to share the objectives and methods to be used for improving the aesthetics of the potential pump station. This artist discussion will be an opportunity to provide feedback about what images, art, murals, sculptures, or words the community would like to see that will enhance and beautify the potential pump station.
