Subject: Local Transportation Climate Adaptation Program \$12 Million

Award - Coastal Rail Infrastructure Resiliency Study

I am pleased to share that, last week, the California Transportation Commission (CTC) awarded \$12 million in Local Transportation Climate Adaptation Program (LTCAP) funds to support environmental studies for the Coastal Rail Infrastructure Resiliency Corridor. The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) submitted the application to the CTC for consideration in July 2023. This effort will help fund environmental work or the next step in delivering potential near-term solutions, which will be identified in the Coastal Rail Resiliency Study, currently underway, to minimize service disruptions, enhance passenger rail safety, and protect coastal rail assets. The environmental studies are expected to be complete early 2028.
