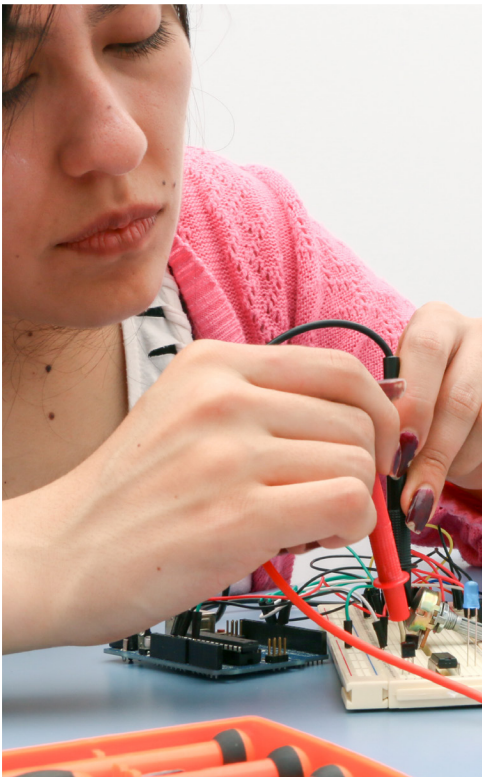


Electronics Technician, Correctional Facility (CF)



Job Description

The Electronics Technician, CF, under direction installs, maintains, repairs, and operates various types of the less complex electronic devices and equipment; maintains order and supervises the conduct of inmates; protects and maintains the safety of persons and property; may instruct, lead, or supervise inmates.

(College education with major work in electrical or electronic engineering may be substituted for one year of the above experience, on the basis of one year of education being equivalent to six months of experience.)
