Description, Compensation and Benefits:

Description - Installation of energy conservation measures on the residences of low-income clients in Placer, Nevada, and Eldorado counties to make their homes more energy efficient and to reduce their utility bills.

Compensation – Wage range \$17-\$24 per hour (depending upon experience)

Benefits – Beginning after 60 days of employment, a monthly “allowance” of over \$1,000. may be used to select benefits from our “menu”, including health, dental, life, accident, etc. insurances and 401-k Retirement. Depending upon tenure, 1-5 weeks of paid vacation and all employees receive 12 paid holidays. A company vehicle and most tools and equipment are provided by Project GO. (Certain terms and conditions are applicable).

Qualifications and Job Requirements:

Knowledge of basic and advanced construction concepts and techniques. Ability to read and write at a level required to legibly complete complex forms; evaluate the quality of work performed; safely operate vehicles and equipment including power tools, duct blaster, blower door test equipment, combustion test equipment, monoxer test equipment, and other energy efficiency testing devices. The employee is regularly required to stand, sit, climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl, walk, use hands, reach with hands and arms, and talk or hear. The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 100 pounds. Placer, Nevada and Eldorado Counties includes the Lake Tahoe area, which may require overnight travel (per diem is paid in addition to wages). Employee must be able to provide a clean DMV record and a valid Driver’s License.

About the Organization:

Established in 1978, Project GO is the Community Action Agency for Placer County. We receive state, federal and utility grant funding to hire crews to install energy conservation measures, including (but not limited to) attic insulation, caulking, weatherstripping, water conservation measures, and energy efficiency testing. We have assisted over 50,000 low-income clients in Placer and Nevada counties since our inception.
