Chipping services in September decreased due to excessive heat and unhealthy air quality from the Mosquito Fire. Our online system, HubSpot, is up and running and the Chipper Crews have been trained. Customers can now make requests and pay their requests online. Since the soft launch last week, we've received 9 requests from the online portal. Letters were sent out the first week of August to collect unpaid invoices, and another round of letters were sent out the first week of September. We have been able to collect \$4,480 thus far. Follow up calls will continue to be made. The estimated wait time is currently 1-week, with less than 20 on the wait list.
