INTERSTATE STATE 80

- 1** **Where:** SIE/NEV 80 PM 1.59-31.37, near Nevada state line and Mystic
What: Regrade slope, excavate rock and install drapery system
When: May-July
Expected Delays: Intermittent lane closures with delays up to 20 minutes
- 2** **Where:** NEV 80 PM 13-16.5, Donner Pass Road to 80/89/267 interchange
What: Pavement rehabilitation, installation of westbound auxiliary lane and eastbound accelerations lanes
When: May-August
Expected Delays: Intermittent lane closures with delays up to 20 minutes
- 3** **Where:** NEV 80 PM 16.3-21.2, 0.6 miles east of Trout Creek to Truckee River Bridge
What: Pavement repairs
When: June-November
Expected Delays: Intermittent lane closures with delays up to 20 minutes
- 4** **Where:** NEV 80 PM 16.3-18.8, Interstate 80/89/267 interchange to Agricultural Station
What: Striping reconfiguration to add third lane
When: July-November
Expected Delays: Intermittent lane closures with delays up to 20 minutes



STATE ROUTE 28

- 5** **Where:** PLA 28 PM 0.2-9.34, Tahoe City to Kings Beach
What: Liberty Utility and Southwest Gas utility relocation work; pavement repairs
When: May-November
Expected Delays: One-way traffic control at multiple locations with delays up to 30 minutes



U.S. HIGHWAY 50

- 7** **Where:** DO 4.2-5.5; US 50, west of Warrior Way to east of Tahoe Drive
What: Install traffic signal and infiltration basin, safety hydraulic improvements
When: June-October
Expected Delays: Intermittent lane closures; public parking restrictions on shoulders of US 50

STATE ROUTE 28

- 8** **Where:** DO 0.0-WA 2.4; SR 28 between Sand Harbor and Spooner Summit
What: Incline Village General Improvement District pipeline replacement, phase 2
When: May-October
Expected Delays: One-way traffic control with delays up to 20 minutes

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Interstate 80

Rock Fall Protection

Nevada and Sierra counties from 1.9 miles east of Farad Undercrossing to Sierra County line, and from 1.3 miles east of the Nevada County line to the Nevada state line.

The improvements are part of a \$12.6 million project to stabilize the cut slope along I-80 westbound just west of the California-Nevada state line to prevent continued rockfall onto shoulder areas and the roadway. The project will include flattening the existing slope, installing drapery systems, and constructing concrete barriers and valley gutters.

The project started last summer and will continue this summer with completion scheduled by late July.

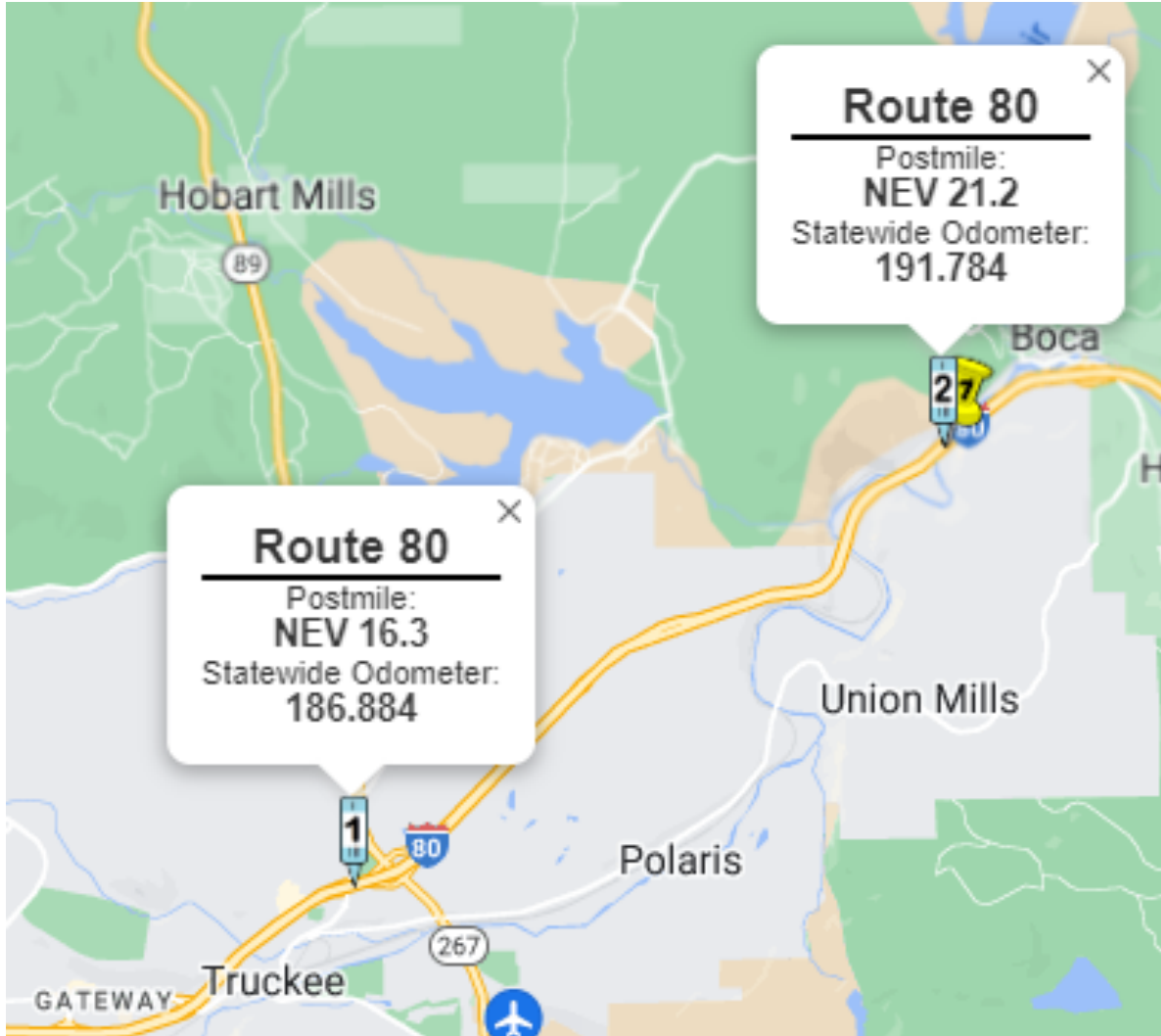


Interstate 80 | Truckee Auxiliary Lane

Donner Pass Road interchange to Highway 89/267 interchange

The work is part of a \$30.6 million project to rehabilitate the existing concrete on I-80 in Truckee, install a westbound auxiliary lane from the State Route 89 south on-ramp to the Donner Pass Road off-ramp, install eastbound acceleration lanes from the Donner Pass Road on-ramp and State Route 89 south on-ramp, improve drainage, and upgrade concrete walkways along ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

The project is scheduled to be completed by late August.

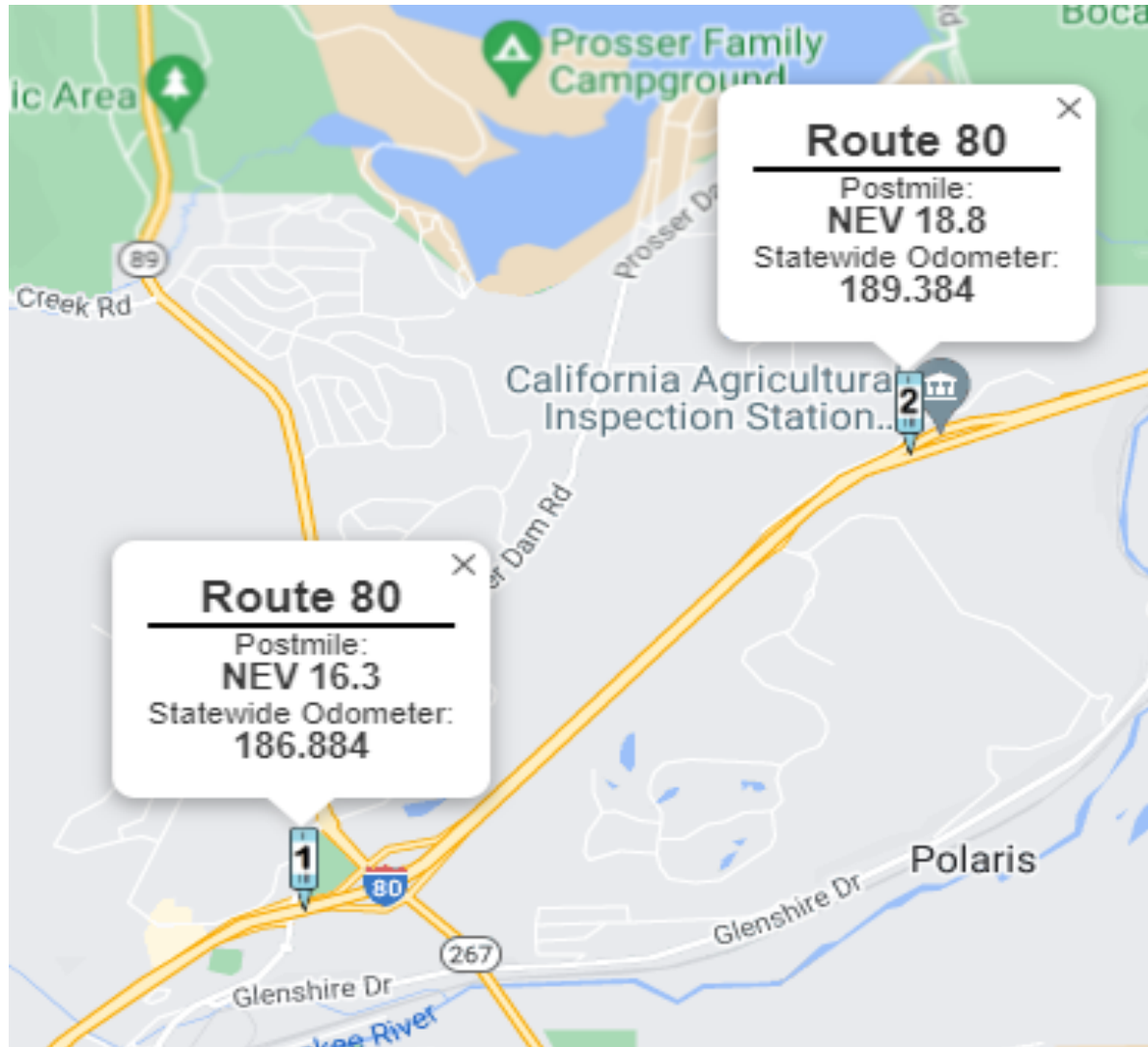


Interstate 80 | Nevada County

Pavement Repairs

In Nevada County from 0.6 miles east of Trout Creek to the Truckee River Bridge. Repaving will occur in both directions between June – November, weather permitting.

Intermittent lane closures with delays up to 20 minutes.



Westbound I- 80 Truck Climbing Lane

On westbound I-80 between the agriculture inspection station to the Highway 89/267 interchange.

A third lane for truck climbing will be constructed and the highway will be restriped to reflect the new lane.

Work will take place between July – November.

Intermittent lane closures with delays up to 20 minutes

Emergency Pothole Repairs on Highways 28, 89, and 267

On Highway 28 between Tahoe City and Kings Beach.

On Highway 267 between Northstar Drive and Kings Beach.

On Highway 89 between West River Street (Truckee) and Tahoe City.

This is an ongoing repair project to address damages to the highways from this past winter's heavy precipitation. This work is part of a \$8 million emergency contract to do pavement repairs.

Work is scheduled to be completed by the end of June.



Carnelian Bay

Highway 28 Crosswalk

On Highway 28 between Center Street and Carnelian Bay Avenue.

Exact timing still to be determined and is scheduled for some time this summer.

This project will install a marked crosswalk and pedestrian activated Rectangular Rapid Flash Beacon (RRFB).

2024 Projects

- Liberty Electric will underground overhead wires from Beach St (near Safeway in Kings Beach) to Onyx in the Carnelian Bay area.
- Dig outs and repaving of the roadbed on Highway 28 in Tahoe City from Save mart to Safeway.
- Install 3 new flashing beacons for pedestrian crossings in Tahoe City.
- Green bike lane treatment in Tahoe City.
- Undergrounding new broadband from Tahoe City to the SR267/28 intersection in Kings Beach (9 miles of trenching) – this is still pending.
- Repaving all of Highway 28 from the Save mart in Tahoe City to the Stateline (11 miles). This work is expected to take 2 seasons to complete.



2024 Fanny Bridge Replacement

This is a Central Federal Lands (CFL) project which is part of FHWA. This is expected to take 11 weeks to complete, and the work will take place from mid July to October.

CFL has coordinated with the businesses near this bridge.

Traffic will be re-routed to use SR28 to the new roundabouts recently installed to avoid this location.



2025 Tahoe City Wye Roundabout Project

This project is scheduled to begin in April/May 2025.

The intersection will be converted into a roundabout.

This is another Central Federal Lands (CFL) project.

Southwest Gas will do utility relocations during the roundabout construction.



2026 or 2027 Projects

Potential construction of a roundabout at the SR 267/28 intersection in Kings Beach, pending funding.

Placer County is the lead agency.
