- Oracle continually makes updates based on customer feedback and best practices
- Beginning in May 2020, the current look and feel will not be supported by Oracle (updates won't be applied, bugs or service request cannot be logged for old user interface)

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<b>What's Changing?</b>	<b>What's NOT Changing?</b>
<p><b>Homepage will have new look and feel with updated colors and layout.</b></p>	<p><b>Overall Oracle functionality is not changing.</b></p>
<p><b>Navigation within Employee Self-Service will look different.</b></p>	<p><b>Manager Self-Service for Workflow Approval is not changing.</b></p>
<p><b>Manager Self-Service will see the biggest change in navigation &amp; functionality.</b></p>	<p><b>Navigation within the Financial modules (e.g., Budget, General Accounting, Procurement, Projects, etc.) is not changing.</b></p>

**Homepage Layout**

**Tabs** group together related icons on your springboard. Use the caret to scroll to additional tabs as needed.

**Quick Actions** provide a shortcut to tasks you perform.

The **springboard** contains icons used to access various work areas.

# ERP - New Look and Feel Training Approach

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- **Department Administrators** \*
  - Will be invited to Employee Self Service (ESS) and Manager Self Service (MSS) demo April 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> – they will serve as subject matter experts
  - May contact their assigned HR Technician with questions
- **Managers**
  - Work with their Department Administrators to complete transactions using the new user interface
- **Employees**
  - Will use a Basic Navigation job aid to orient themselves to the new layout
  - Will use a general Employee Self-Service (ESS) job aid to orient themselves on the new ESS navigation
  - May contact their Department Administrators or their assigned HR Technician with questions

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## *What do we need from you?*

- Ensure your employees are aware of the changes coming to the look and feel of Oracle taking place **April 27th**
