- 1. APPROVE THE RECOGNIZED OBLIGATION PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR JANUARY–JUNE 2016 AND ADMINISTRATIVE BUDGET [FUNDING SOURCE: PROPERTY TAX INCREMENT DISTRIBUTED FROM THE REDEVELOPMENT PROPERTY TAX TRUST FUND]

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**SR1. SUBJECT: APPROVE THE RECOGNIZED OBLIGATION PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR JANUARY–JUNE 2016 AND ADMINISTRATIVE BUDGET (DISTRICTS: ALL)**

**OVERVIEW:**

On January 24, 2012 (14), the County of San Diego was designated as the Successor Agency to oversee the wind-down of the former redevelopment agency's operations following the steps established by AB 1X26, the Dissolution Act, which include preserving assets, fulfilling legally binding commitments, overseeing the termination of activities, and returning resources expeditiously to the affected taxing entities. The Redevelopment Agency of the County of San Diego was dissolved on February 1, 2012.

The Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS), prepared semiannually, is the report that authorizes the amount of former redevelopment agency property tax increment to be allocated to the successor agency for payment of enforceable obligations. The County Successor Agency is required to submit the ROPS and the administrative budget semiannually to the County Oversight Board.

Approval of the ROPS for January-June 2016 (ROPS 15-16B) and the related administrative budget for the same period is requested. Total enforceable obligations of \$812,820 are eligible to be funded, including an administrative budget of \$41,000. If approved, both items will be presented to the County Oversight Board on September 22, 2015 for approval and subsequent transmission to the State Department of Finance before the deadline of October 5, 2015. The ROPS 15-16B, as with all ROPS, may be changed by the County Oversight Board or the Department of Finance.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The payments shown on the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule for January – June 2016, including the administrative budget, are included in the Fiscal Year 2015-16 Operational Plan for the Successor Agency. The funding source is property tax increment distributed from the Redevelopment Property Tax Trust Fund.
