BACKGROUND

District 4 Supervisor Nathan Fletcher, by his own statements demonstrated he has not upheld the principles of integrity expected in his position as a member of the County Board of Supervisors. Our County culture allows no room for sexual harassment or misconduct. Our robust County policies and Code of Ethics for the workplace should be honored and respected by all, regardless of position.

On March 28, 2023, Supervisor Nathan Fletcher was named in a civil lawsuit alleging sexual assault. While the matter is being handled in the justice system, on March 29, 2023, Supervisor Nathan Fletcher admitted he had been involved, which he described as "consensual interactions", with a female employee at the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS).

It is the Policy of the County Board of Supervisor's (Policy Number C-22, "Sexual Harassment Policy") that the County of San Diego will provide a work environment free of sexual harassment. As such, the County is committed to the principle of treating each employee with respect and dignity and is committed to a work environment free from unlawful discrimination and harassment.

The work of the Board of Supervisors must continue to move forward to meet the needs of all county residents, including over 675,000 residents of District 4.

Through this action, the Board is requested to adopt a resolution of no confidence in Supervisor Nathan Fletcher and demand his immediate resignation.

WHEREAS, MTS Board leadership launched an independent investigation into the sexual harassment allegations against Supervisor Nathan Fletcher.

WHEREAS, all members of the County Board of Supervisors stand in support of the investigation and look forward to the findings being made public.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the County Board of Supervisors has lost confidence in District 4 Supervisor Nathan Fletcher.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors demand his immediate resignation.
