What is Care Connect?

Vista Hill's *Care Connect* program focuses on addressing the needs of San Diego County residents who are enrolled in Medi-Cal.

Vista Hill's *Care Connect* program provides what is known as "Enhanced Care Management," or ECM, services.

Care Connect assists children, youth and families with complex medical and social needs at no cost.

Enrollment and discontinuation of services at any time are hassle-free.

Interpreter services are available when needed.

▶ Eligibility Requirements

To participate in Care Connect, you must:



Reside in San Diego County

Be enrolled in one of the following Medi-Cal plans:

- BlueShield
- Kaiser (youth only)
- Molina (youth only)

Be a youth (services include the whole family) who, in the last 12 months, has experienced at least one of the following:

- Homelessness or loss of a stable housing situation
- Multiple avoidable hospital or emergency department visits
- Serious mental health or substance use needs
- Transition from a youth correctional facility
- Enrollment in California Children's Services (CCS) or CCS Whole Child Model (WCM) with additional needs beyond the CCS condition
- · Involvement in child welfare
- An intellectual or developmental disability AND one of the above
- Pregnant or postpartum and at risk for adverse outcomes

How to

Assuming you are eligible under one of the qualified Medi-Cal plans and reside in San Diego County, there is no cost to you. You can also unenroll anytime.
