Substance Use Disorder Intensive Outpatient Teen Recovery Center Services

Service Description

Intensive Teen Recovery Center (ITRC) provides countywide substance use disorder (SUD) intensive outpatient treatment services for adolescents up to 21 years of age and their families. The ITRC provides 9-19 hours of clinical service per week for adolescents who meet American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) criteria for Level 2.1 Intensive Outpatient and 20+ hours of clinical service per week for those in need of Level 2.5, High Intensity Outpatient treatment. ITRC services include individual and group counseling, family education and family therapy, care coordination, on-site Medication for Addiction Treatment (MAT), peer support, relapse prevention skill-building, and introduction to prosocial activities.
