

Request for Proposals (RFP):

School-Based Skill Building

Service Description

Provision of outpatient specialty mental health services in the form of school-based social emotional skill building groups using an evidence-based or community-defined curriculum, as well as providing ancillary services.

The focus population for services is Medi-Cal eligible youth primarily in grades 6-8 (youth in grades 4-5 would also be acceptable), who have emerging social-emotional or behavioral health concerns. The intent is to award 5 regionally-based contracts.

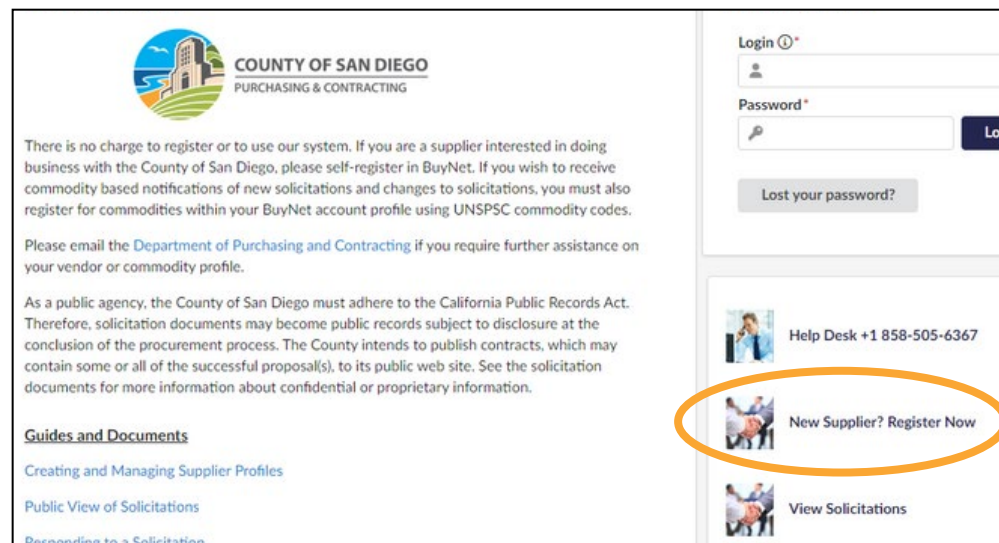
