SHELTER SERVICES:

Betty's Village serves self-identified women and children who have experienced domestic violence or human trafficking.

Casa de Ruby is the nation's first shelter and transitional housing program specifically for men who are victims of human trafficking.

House of Acceptance is a transitional housing program for transgender women who have been victims of human trafficking.



EDUCATION & OUTREACH

Outreach Case Management provides advocacy, case management, & direct service connection to people not living in our shelters or housing.

Bedside Advocacy partners with local agencies to provide bedside advocacy in hospitals & medical clinics for individuals that are victims of human trafficking.

Case Management is a collaborative process that assesses, plans, implements, coordinates, and evaluates the options and services required to meet clients' needs.
