*Chad Opitz is currently a Detective with the Beaverton Police Department in Beaverton, Oregon and a Task Force Officer on the Portland FBI Child Exploitation Task Force. He is a twenty-two (22) year law enforcement officer and has been a detective for the last fifteen. Detective Opitz is also assigned as an Investigator to the Washington County Major Crimes Team. He has worked sex trafficking related crimes since 2008, with the focus on protecting minors. Detective Opitz is currently the primary investigator on all sex trafficking cases with the Beaverton Police Department.*
