Travel back in time and experience the memories from The Beatles as you transport yourself back to 1963 when this groundbreaking band skyrocketed in success! The exhibition at the de Young Museum in San Francisco showcases a brief slice of time for the fab four. On display are 250 personal photos taken through the eyes of Paul McCartney while touring the United States and England. The photos, video clips, and archival materials feature moments both behind and in front of the camera of McCartney and bandmates John Lennon, George Harrison, and Ringo Starr. The photos were only rediscovered in recent years, having remained as unprinted negatives for decades. The cost includes an audio tour and entry to additional collection galleries at the de Young on the day of your visit. Please bring cash/credit card as lunch is at your own leisure at the Museum Café. ***Daytrips are non-refundable.***
