The versatile Beneteau First 235 (SN #85), adorned in red sails and rigging, is slipped at Dillon Marina in B21 and IT IS FOR SALE for just \$13,500. There is plenty of season left in 2025 so get it now. This particular sailboat (especially with this kit) is rarely available... it's registered among all the First 235 owners worldwide on a fan site so if you track that, you know. Cross the Med, sail the BVI, trailer to all the lakes in CO or anywhere else. Or keep it in Summit County, CO for the killer summer season here. This keen racer cruiser sailboat has sailed Dillon Rez for 10 years since I bought it from a Coast Guard sailor/owner who'd tricked it out with autohelm, rail-attachable grill, paddles, floatation vests, tons of spare parts, sails, and more. I significantly upgraded Mon Ami further to run well if just self-sailing; the tiller is outfitted with an extension to control from the deck; the rolling furler and all other moving rigging are rolled back to the cabin for easy access. Other upgrades include:

- new electric brakes on the trailer (better for crossing mountain passes now)
- a brand new \$2800 Suzuki 9.9hp outdrive with electric and pull start and easy electric lift
- a newish (8 seasons) \$1300 Mack 130 front sail on a newish (7 seasons) \$1200 heavy duty Harkin rolling furler
