



## STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

April 18, 2018

On March 19, 2018, Michael Dougherty, Democratic candidate for District Attorney for the 20th Judicial District, submitted 1,629 petition signatures to the Secretary of State. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 26, 2018, primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Dougherty's petition must contain at least 1,000 valid signatures.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Under section 1-4-801(2)(b), C.R.S., a major party district attorney candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand signers or signers equal to thirty percent of the votes cast in the district at the contested or uncontested primary election for the political party's candidate for the office for which the petition is being circulated . . . ."
