

2019 Streets Project

The reconstruction of Coalton Road from Indiana Street to Rock Creek Parkway is substantially complete except for a few pavement markings and clean-up. Traffic has reverted to the original four-lane configuration. A new mid-block pedestrian crossing on Coalton controlled by rectangular rapid flashing beacons near the Safeway shopping center is operational with the completion of the project.



The Autrey Park parking lot has been expanded and paved. It provides parking for the dog park as well as the skate park.



A new trailhead parking lot on the former Shan Shan property off of McCaslin Blvd south of Original Town has been constructed to provide access to the Mayhoffer-Singletree trail network. It will open in mid-November.



Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program

The Town's Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (NTCP) implements engineering, education, and enforcement to slow speeding traffic on residential streets. The NTCP is administered by the [Public Works & Utilities Department](#) in conjunction with the [Transportation & Safety Committee \(TSC\)](#).
