Town of Superior Special Election Tuesday, November 2, 2021

A Special Election for the Town of Superior will be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021. This election is a coordinated election with Boulder County and is a **mail ballot election**. Mail ballots will be sent to all active voters by Boulder County. Boulder County will send mail ballots out on Friday, October 8, 2021.

This election will be for a TABOR issue as follows:

SHALL TOWN OF SUPERIOR TAXES ΒE INCREASED \$1,100,000 ANNUALLY IN THE FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR (2022), AND BY ANOTHER \$500,000 ANNUALLY IN THE SECOND (2023),FISCAL YEAR AND BY WHATEVER ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS ARE COLLECTED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, BY AN INCREASE IN THE SALES AND USE TAX RATE OF 0.28% IN 2022 AND 0.16% IN 2023, SALES AND USE TAX RATE INCREASE PHASED-IN TOTALING 0.44% OVER TWO YEARS, WITH THE REVENUES FROM SUCH TAX INCREASE TO ΒE USED FOR SHALL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS; AND THE TOWN BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN, AND SPEND ALL SUCH REVENUE AND ANY INVESTMENT **EARNINGS** INTEREST THEREON WITHOUT LIMITATION AND WITHOUT LIMITING THE EXPENDITURE OF ANY OTHER REVENUES OR 20, UNDER ARTICLE Χ, SECTION THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION?
