

## Dear Superior residents,


Welcome to Spring Superior! Today, I want to tell you more about the Superior Community Center.

The Community Center features a library area, a cafe, meeting spaces, and a youth room called "the Spot." It is also packed full of programming and events.

The library area is curated by the Louisville Public Library. You can browse and check out books from the shelves or arrange to have books reserved online and delivered for pickup at the book lockers.

Small and large meeting rooms can be arranged for your needs and are available for residents to reserve for free up to two times per month. I've seen birthday parties, baby showers, cub scout meetings, the young men's service league meetup and more.

We also have an open area equipped with stadium seating for small performances (my kids had their piano recital there one year), educational conferences, or professional seminars. The monthly "Chat with the Chief" event also takes place here.



There's flexible seating for those looking to work or study and a lounge area where you can relax. The Serendipity Tap and Café offers refreshments like smoothies, frappes, your favorite coffee drinks, delicious pastries, breakfast burritos, salads, sandwiches, and charcuterie boxes. They also serve beer and wine.

The SCC also offers many different types of programming, including Improv Classes, our new Superior Community Choir, Tai Chi for Arthritis and Fall Prevention, Ukulele Classes, Chess Wizards, CBArt Classes, JumpBunch for toddlers, and lots more. On weekends, you can attend Jammin' Music Bingo which is a Town favorite, or check out some live music.

The Superior Community Center opened in 2021 and has quickly become a true community asset, with more than 1,000 people visiting it weekly. If you haven't visited yet, please do yourself a favor and check it out. It's an awesome community amenity.
