



Door-to-Door Solicitation: What Residents Should Know

The Town of Superior has regulations in place to help protect residents' privacy while allowing permitted door-to-door solicitation. These rules were adopted by the Board of Trustees in 2008.

What is Solicitation?

Solicitation occurs when someone goes door-to-door without being invited to sell goods or services or request donations. Examples include home improvement sales (roofing, siding, etc.), magazine subscriptions, and similar sales activities. Political canvassing, political advocacy, and religious outreach are **not** considered solicitation under this ordinance.

Permits Are Required

Anyone conducting door-to-door solicitation in Superior must obtain a **solicitation permit** from the Town. Applicants undergo a background check, and permits are issued to individuals for one year. Solicitors must carry their permit and identification at all times and present them upon request.

No Solicitation Signs

Residents may also post a **"No Solicitors" or "No Trespassing"** sign on their property. Signs must be visible and no larger than **2.5 square feet**. Soliciting at a property with one of these signs is a violation.

Door Hangers and Hours

Promotional materials may not be left on private property without permission. Solicitation is only allowed **between 8 a.m. and no later than 8 p.m. or sunset**.

Reporting Concerns

If someone is soliciting **without a permit**, residents should contact the **Boulder County Sheriff's Office non-emergency dispatch at 303-441-4444**.

Do Not Solicit List

Residents who do not wish to receive door-to-door sales visits may register their address on the Town's **Do Not Solicit List**. Permitted solicitors receive this list and are instructed not to approach those homes.

Please note that the Do Not Solicit List only applies to permitted solicitors. Individuals who solicit without a permit are already in violation of Town regulations and should be reported.
