- Secure all doors, windows & gates: Frightened pets may try to escape.
- Safe space: Have your pet's crate or favorite hiding space accessible.
- Play calming music: Drown out noise with familiar, soothing sounds.
- Anxiety vest: Consider putting an anti-anxiety vest on your dog.
- Update ID tags & microchips: Make sure the information is correct in case they run off.
- Never bring pets to fireworks displays: It's overwhelming and dangerous.
- Watch for heat: Keep them cool, hydrated, and don't leave them in hot cars.
