

Optional: Students may submit a recent piece of outstanding, original and colorful artwork with a theme of their choice (same guidelines as above.) All D.C. artwork must be submitted ELECTRONICALLY via email to latinoartbeat@hotmail.com. Include the Art Competition entry form and a one paragraph essay describing the artwork. The ORIGINAL WINNING artwork (once announced) will be required to be sent to Latino Art Beat in Chicago from the winners and honorable mentions

FILM & ANIMATION COMPETITION

• Filmmakers may submit Films of 15 minutes or less with original score as Narratives, PSA's, Documentaries or Animation. Films to be submitted via electronic media directly to Latino Art Beat, i.e. VIMEO, Drop Box, YouTube, etc. Link and password must be included along with a copy of the Film Competition Entry Form.
