CRIMINAL REPORT AFFIDAVIT/ HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY, FLORIDA

The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did: On August 14, 2023, at approximately 12:40 AM, I, Trooper Logan, and Sergeant Moore were responding to a dark sedan traveling southbound in the northbound lanes of State Road 589 at mile marker 4. While responding, we got an update that the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office located the sedan and attempted to stop the sedan. The sedan then fled from the Sheriff's Office. The Sheriff's Office was following the vehicle and keeping Sergeant Moore and I updated of the sedan's location. Sergeant Moore and I were able to locate a vehicle that matched the description given to us by the Sheriff's Office. I observed a dark sedan bearing Florida license plate [REDACTED] traveling east on State Road 580, approaching the intersection of N Armenia Drive. The vehicle was smoking, and the front tires were falling off. The vehicle had a driving pattern indicating that the driver was extremely impaired. Sergeant Moore and I activated our blue emergency lights and sirens, and attempted to conduct a traffic stop.

The vehicle slowed and began to move to the painted median, then took evasive action around my marked black and tan patrol car and attempted to flee to the east. Sergeant Moore then used the PIT to stop the vehicle. The driver of the sedan attempted to escape the pit. I positioned my patrol car to stop the dark sedan from fleeing the scene.

The driver refused to exit the vehicle. I then removed the driver from the vehicle and placed him in handcuffs. I then asked the driver for his name. The driver provided the name of William Smith. Sergeant Moore located paperwork with the name Billy Wayne Spencer, date of birth [REDACTED], by his Florida driver license [REDACTED]. Mr. Spencer was identified as the driver. The driver knew that he had given me a false name.

While the driver was talking, I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from the driver's mouth that became stronger as he kept talking. I also observed that the driver's eyes were bloodshot, watery, and glassy.

I asked the driver if he would be willing to perform standardized field sobriety exercises. The driver refused. I then asked the driver for a breath sample. The driver refused to answer my question and stayed silent. I informed the driver that I would take his silence as a no. I then read the driver implied consent at 1:22 AM. The driver refused to answer my question and stayed silent. [REDACTED] The driver was then transported to the Hillsborough County Jail without incident.

While at the Hillsborough County Jail, 19 20-dollar bills that were identified as counterfeit were located in the driver's property mixed in with other US currency.

This all occurred in Hillsborough County, Florida.
