1) The appropriate vendor fees. Retail/Service Vendors - fees are processed only if the application is accepted. Once accepted, the vendor fee is non-refundable. Below are the sponsor levels and prices:

- \$5,000 for Platinum Sponsor applications
- \$3,000 for Gold Sponsor applications
- \$1,000 for Silver Sponsor applications
- \$100 for event vendor applications

4. I understand and agree to release, waive, and discharge the City and its agents, employees, elected and appointed officials, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, sales persons, photographers, and volunteers, (hereinafter called "Releasees") from any and all liability for personal injury, property damages, property theft or any other claims of any kind which relate to or arise in whole or in part from the Releasee's negligence or in any way relate to my participation in this Event.
