RE: Letter of Permission (LOP) and Revocable License (RL) for Maintenance of a Commercial Marina, 1418 Sapelo Avenue, Roscoe Canal, McIntosh County, Georgia. (GPS: 31.53585°N/-81.36283°W)

Dear Mr. Phillips:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request dated March 11, 2020 for maintenance to an existing commercial marina. The project consists of replacing pilings and floor structures in their existing footprint and configuration on three (3) enclosed buildings located over coastal marshlands. The project will begin no sooner than fifteen (15) days from the receipt of this letter and be completed within six (6) months.

The existing structure consists of three (3) irregular shaped, enclosed buildings totaling 4,589 square feet extending from the upland. The area to be repaired consists of portions of the floor of each building for a total of 1,980 square feet. The old concrete floor will be removed, and new concrete floors will be placed in the same footprint. Pilings will be replaced by installing new pilings through the roof of the structure, piling replacement will occur within or immediately adjacent to the original structure. Unserviceable pilings will be removed or cut off at the mud line.

The Department authorizes the maintenance of the commercial marina in the current footprint as depicted in the attached description and drawings. No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed in, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. All material removed must be disposed of at an appropriate upland disposal area. Any visible alterations in marsh topography will be restored immediately using low-impact hand tools. Any damage to the marsh vegetation that has not recovered naturally during the next growing season will be repaired by a method acceptable to the Department.

Please find enclosed a fully executed Revocable License (RL) for the project described above. This license serves as an authorization to utilize state owned tidal water bottoms for your project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without

prior notification and approval from this office could result in revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures.

This authorization does not relieve you from obtaining any other required federal, state, or local permits. Tidal water bottoms and marshlands of coastal Georgia are public trust lands controlled by the State, except for such lands where a validated Crown Grant or State Grant exists.

This letter is regarding the proposed maintenance for the existing building, existing fixed decks, and associated pilings. The proposed improvements, as shown on the attached exhibit, will consist of repairing/replacing portion of the buildings, fixed decks, and pilings

- T. R. Long Engineering, P.C. met on site with Mr. Noble, and Mr. Phillips to highlight the areas and discuss the estimated methods of repair. As discussed, the concrete deck will be replaced by concrete decking and the base will be stabilized. Any failing pilings under the existing fixed decks and buildings will be replaced by fiberglass pilings.
- T. R. Long Engineering, P.C., on behalf of the applicant, preformed an on-site survey to approximate the area of improvements. The survey was used to provide an estimation for the dilapidated areas and provide an exhibit to Department of Natural Resource to ensure the associated repairs will be within the regular maintenance of the approved dock and facilities.


Adam,
