IMPORTANT/NEW COVID-19 Vaccine Information

- FDA Authorizes Bivalent Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine as Booster Dose for Certain Children 6 Months through 4 Years of Age
 - Effective immediately, children, 6 months through 4 years of age, who completed their three-dose primary series with the <u>monovalent</u> Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine more than two months ago are now eligible to receive a single booster dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine, Bivalent.

FDA Authorizes Bivalent Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine as Booster Dose for Certain Children 6 Months through 4 Years of Age

On March 14, 2023, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration amended the emergency use authorization (EUA) of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine, Bivalent to provide for a single booster dose of the vaccine in children 6 months through 4 years of age at least 2 months after completion of primary vaccination with three doses of the monovalent (single strain) Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine.

Effective immediately, children, 6 months through 4 years of age, who completed the three-dose primary series with the <u>monovalent</u> Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine more than two months ago are now eligible to receive a single booster dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine, Bivalent.

Since December 2022, children 6 months through 4 years of age who receive the first two doses with monovalent Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine should complete the three-dose primary series with Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine, Bivalent. Children in this age group were not eligible for a booster dose of a bivalent vaccine. The authorization is for those children 6 months through 4 years of age who completed the 3-dose primary vaccination series with the monovalent Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine, before the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine, Bivalent was authorized to provide the third dose in the 3-dose primary series.
