IA-CL-06 NOTIFICATION: ANNOUNCEMENT OF LAUNCH

Attention Providers,

This notification is to inform Providers required to use Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) for Home Health Services (HHS) being billed on an institutional (837i) claim that the changes to Home Health Services 837i claim elements are required to be set up as of today, **October 1, 2024** in the CareBridge EVV Provider portal.

Changes to Home Health Services 837i Claim Elements

As a reminder, the following data fields can now be set with static or dynamic values, offering greater flexibility and control over your claims:

- Attending Provider
- Referring Provider
- Facility Type Code
- Claim Frequency Code for Initial Claims
- Patient Status Code
- Admission Date/Patient Certification
- Condition Codes
- Value Code

Provider Action

Any HHS provider that has not completed their claim setup in the CareBridge Provider portal will experience billing alerts until necessary action is taken. **Providers who do not take the necessary action risk delays in claims submission.**
