Dear Supervisors and Sheriff Marx:

It has come to my attention that on February 4, 2025, the Sheriff posted the attached letter on social media which indicates the sheriff's office will not comply with a detainer request from U. S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, a federal law enforcement agency.

I direct your attention to Iowa Code chapter 27A on enforcement of immigration laws. Specifically, Iowa law provides a sheriff shall not adopt or enforce a policy or take any other action under which the sheriff prohibits or discourages the enforcement of immigration laws. Iowa law further requires that a sheriff shall not prohibit or discourage a law enforcement officer from assisting or cooperating with a federal immigration officer as reasonable or necessary, including providing enforcement assistance.

Based on the sheriff's posted policy, this letter shall be treated as a complaint I am filing with the attorney general pursuant to Iowa Code §27A.8. Understand that a sheriff and county can become ineligible to receive any state funds if the local entity is found to have intentionally violated the provisions of chapter 27A.
