
2021 Mail from the Assessor's Office



- Over 200,000 homeowners receiving multiple exemption renewals will get a confirmation letter.
- If only the Homeowner and Senior Exemptions were renewed, a postcard was sent.
- **2020 only:** If renewed for the Senior Freeze, or the Veterans/Persons with Disabilities, a navy letter in an envelope (for privacy) was sent.



- The Gold Booklet identifies those that need to recertify their eligibility.
- Contains Homeowner, Senior, and Senior Freeze paper applications.
- Applicants can mail the form + document copies in the included envelope, or apply online.



- The Purple Booklet identifies homeowners that should apply if eligible (e.g., new homeowner, or unclaimed exemptions).
- Contains Homeowner, Senior, and Senior Freeze paper applications.
- Applicants can mail form + document copies in the included envelope, or apply online.



- The CCAO has determined that a property owner met one qualification for the Longtime Exemption.
 Typically, fewer than 2% of homes qualify.
- If they meet all qualifications, applicants must provide copies of documents, get the forms notarized, and mail these documents to our Office.
