NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS:

The victim's black Infiniti sedan was parked on the fourth floor of a parking garage in the 3000 Block of S. Des Plaines River Road at the above mentioned time. The Unknown Offender exits a white coupe in the area, approaches the passenger side and smashes the window on the victim's vehicle. The offender gains entry to the Infiniti and leaves the garage northbound on Des Plaines River Road.

CRIME REPORT

Des Plaines Police arrested the above subject, Roberto Lopez-Velasco, on May 23, 2023, in relation to an incident that occurred in the 2900 Block of Curtis Street in October 2022. Through investigation it was learned that Lopez-Velasco battered the victim whom he has a relationship with. Due to the nature of the incident, the Cook County State's Attorney's Office was contacted and then approved a felony charge. Lopez-Velasco was subsequently arrested for Aggravated Domestic Battery and was brought to the Cook County Courthouse in Skokie, IL the following day for a bond hearing.

Des Plaines responded to the 2400 Block of E. Ballard Road for the report of a motor vehicle accident. Due to the nature of the accident, the Des Plaines Fire Department was also dispatched to the incident and arrived on scene prior to officers. While arriving, the officer observed DPF was standing by a single vehicle, a Buick LeSabre, and speaking with the driver who was seated in the front driver's seat of the vehicle. The officers learned that Renderos had driven off the roadway and into a ditch as he was coming from the intersection of Ballard Road and Potter Road. The officers observed an empty bottle of alcohol in both the back and front passenger compartments. As Renderos was speaking, the officer detected a strong odor of alcohol emitting from his breath, his eyes were watery/bloodshot, and his speech was slurred. Renderos was having trouble balancing when he was standing and noticed that he was not wearing any shoes. The officer then asked him to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, which he refused. However, the officer suspected that Renderos was intoxicated while driving his vehicle and took him into custody. Renderos was transported to the Des Plaines Police station where Renderos refused any further tests, however, did state that he had consumed alcohol prior to driving. Renderos was subsequently arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and cited for Improper Lane Usage. After posting the required bond, Renderos was released from the station and provided his court information.
