NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS:

OFFENSE: Burglary to Motor Vehicle

LOCATION: 400 Block of Western Avenue

The victim's Ford Transit was parked in the 400 Block of Western Avenue overnight when the Unknown Offender(s) broke a window and stole a power tool from the inside. The officer observed a shattered passenger side window where the offender(s) were able to gain entry. The power tool missing is a red in color Milwaukee Sawzall.

Des Plaines Police responded to a call regarding two male subjects arguing near the bus stop near Miner Street and Pearson Street. The officers arriving on scene located three subjects in the 600 Block of Pearson Street. While speaking with them, the officer noted that the subject, Arvey Wormley, had an open can of alcohol between his legs and was yelling at one of the officers. Wormley was asked for his identification due to the city ordinance violation however, he refused to comply with the officer's request. Wormley continued to refuse to provide any identification event after being warned that it was an arrestable offense. Wormley told officers that he would not identify himself regardless and was taken into custody. After being transported to the Des Plaines Police station, Wormley was searched and in his possession was a small metallic container was two unknown white pills. The officer observed markings on the pills and used that to identify them as hydrocodone. Wormley did not have a prescription for the pills and refused any further questions. Wormley was subsequently arrested for one felony count of Possession of a Controlled Substance; one misdemeanor count of Obstructing a Peace Officer; and one Des Plaines City Ordinance violation for Drinking in a Public Place. Wormley was cited and released with his court information.

Des Plaines Police responded to the 1100 Block of Everett Lane for the report of a domestic situation taking place in a moving vehicle. The officer spoke with the 9-1-1 caller who stated that he was on the phone with the victim and heard a male subject threatening her and identified that male as the subject, Peter Farion. The caller also stated that Farion drives a black Mercedes-Benz sedan and provided the Illinois state registration. Due to the vehicle moving at the time of the call, the officers used the FLOCK camera system to locate the vehicle which was last seen at Irving Park Road and Prospect Avenue in Itasca, IL. DPPD notified the local jurisdictions of the incident and was alerted by the Bensenville Police Department that they had located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. BPD took Farion into custody and transported him to their police department in the 300 Block of E. Green Street in Bensenville, IL. DPPD traveled to BPD and took custody of Farion and brought him to the Des Plaines Police station where they also met with the victim. The victim relayed that she and Farion are in a relationship and after an argument, Farion struck her in the face. Farion was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Domestic Battery and was later brought to a Cook County Courthouse for a detention hearing.
