Due to the recent increase in crime happening at the YMCA building located at 300 E. Northwest Highway, the following are reported incidents at that location:

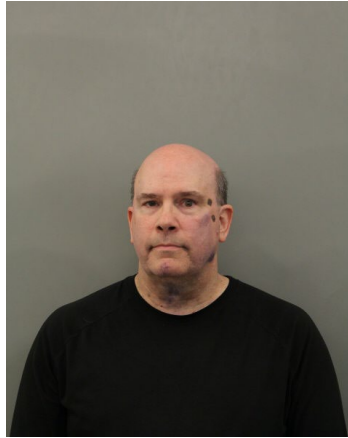

Des Plaines Task Force K9 Officer working with the United States Postal Inspection Service was investigating a suspicious parcel addressed to the 200 Block of S. Wa Pella Avenue in Mount Prospect, IL 60056. K9 was positively alerted to the presence of narcotics inside the packages. With the assistance of the Cook County State's Attorney's Office a search warrant for the residence was obtained and then conducted on May 30, 2024. Officers met with the above subject, Daniel Frytz, who was the listed recipient on the packages and from inside the residence, evidence was recovered verifying that Frytz had accepted the packages. Frytz and all items were recovered and transported to the Des Plaines Police station. All items were weighed and the Cook County ASA's Office was re-contacted and approved felony charges. Frytz was subsequently arrested for one felony count each of Possession of Cannabis 2,000g – 5,000g and Manufacture/Deliver/Possess with Intent to Deliver Cannabis 2,000g – 5,000g. Frytz was cited and released with his court information.

Des Plaines Police responded to the 2100 Block of E. Touhy Avenue for an unwanted subject in the area. As officers responded, Des Plaines Dispatch relayed that the subject, Shane Stoll, was under the influence and not wanted on the property. When officers arrived, they spoke with and obtained identification from Stoll which was then run through the database resulting in an alert for a warrant with the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office. DP Dispatch confirmed with SMCSO that the warrant was valid and extraditable and Stoll was advised of the violation. Stoll was taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where he was subsequently arrested for one count of the Issuance of a Warrant. Stoll was later brought to a Cook County Courthouse for a detention hearing.

On February 29, 2024, Des Plaines Police responded to the 1500 Block of Rand Road for the report of a battery that was occurring. When the officers arrived, all the suspects had fled the area and the officers then spoke with the victim who relayed that while

inside the business he struck up a conversation with two unknown subjects. While waiting to check out at the register, one of the subjects began insulting the victim and shortly after, they began to fight. During the fight, the second unknown subject, later identified as the above Keenan Howard, approached the victim as he was on the ground and began to strike him. Prior to the officers arriving, both Howard and the other subject flee the area. Subject #1 was described as a black male with long braided hair while subject #2 was described as a male black with short light-colored hair and a goatee. This incident was turned over to the Detective Bureau for follow up. During the investigation into the battery, the detective identified a male subject/Howard as matching the description of subject #2 and was later confirmed by the victim on March 26.

On April 11, Des Plaines Police responded to the 100 Block of N. East River Road for the report of a burglary. Once on scene, the officers spoke with an office representative for the complex, who stated that while conducting a walk through of the property on April 9, she observed two vacant storage units inside the complex that appeared to be being lived in. There were multiple personal items and bedding inside the units that she had picked up and stored in the office in case the subjects returned. The representative also stated that the same day, April 9, she had seen a male and female subject walking through the hallways and did not recognize them as residents. Due to previous incidents with the same subjects, the office representative identified the male subject as Keenan Howard. During the investigation, the officers contacted the Cook County State's Attorney's Office and obtained a warrant for Howard.

On May 31, DPPD was dispatched to the 100 Block of S. Des Plaines River Road for a disturbance involving Howard. Des Plaines Dispatch confirmed prior to the officers' arrival that Howard's warrant was still active and upon locating him, the officers took him into custody and transported him to the Des Plaines Police station. Once there, the Cook County ASA's Office was contacted again who then approved felony charges. Howard was subsequently arrested for one felony count of Burglary and one misdemeanor count of Battery. He was later brought to a Cook County Courthouse for a detention hearing.

Des Plaines Police responded to the Rivers Casino located in the 3000 Block of S. Des Plaines River Road for the report of a single vehicle accident in the parking garage. When officers arrived, they located a blue Ford Edge that had crashed into a concrete barrier near the valet side of the building. The officer approached the driver, Zofia Antonik, who was standing next to the driver's door of the Ford. While speaking, Antonik had slurred speech and was mumbling so the officer inquired if she had consumed alcohol prior to driving, which she replied she had. Antonik also had watery and bloodshot eyes which the officer observed during conversation. Antonik was asked, and complied, with a request to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Upon completion, Antonik showed visible signs of impairment and was taken into custody. After being transported to the Des Plaines Police station, Antonik refused all other tests or questions offered and was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Driving Under the Influence and ticketed for the Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle. Antonik was cited and released with her court information.

Des Plaines Police responded to the 1100 Block of Holiday Lane to check the wellbeing of a male subject observed stumbling in the roadway. When the officers arrived, they located the male, later identified as Milton Paniagua, and asked him to sit on the grass as he was having trouble maintaining his balance. While Paniagua was speaking, a strong odor of alcohol emitted from his breath and there was an open bottle of alcohol near him. Paniagua continued to speak and appeared unable to hold a coherent conversation. The officers called the Des Plaines Fire Department to the scene to check on Paniagua. DPFD arrived on scene and advised Paniagua would need to be transported to the hospital when he became combative. Paniagua started swinging his arms and legs and struck one DPFD firefighter in the face and another in the side. Paniagua was ultimately restrained to the stretcher and transported to a local hospital. Officers contacted the Cook County State's Attorney's Office who approved felony charges on Paniagua for the incident. Paniagua was subsequently arrested for two felony counts of Aggravated Battery to a Firefighter and was later brought to a Cook County Courthouse for a detention hearing.

Des Plaines Police responded to the intersection of Oakton Street and Des Plaines River Road for a motor vehicle accident. When on scene, the officers spoke with all parties and learned that the victim was east on Oakton Street in the left turn lane for Des Plaines River Road approaching the red light and the subject, Fernando Diaz Velazquez, was traveling south on Des Plaines River Road actively turning west onto Oakton Street. During the turn, Diaz Velazquez' vehicle slid into the eastbound turn lane and struck the

Upon running the license information for Diaz Velazquez, the officer learned that he did not have a valid driver's license, and said license was revoked by the Illinois Secretary of State. Diaz Velazquez was notified of the violation, taken into custody, and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where he was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Driving on a Revoked Driver's License; ticketed for Driving Too Fast for Conditions and Failure to Reduce Speed to Avoid an Accident. Des Plaines Police received a report of a person at the Rivers Casino located in the 3000 Block of S. Des Plaines River Road with illegal substances inside the business. When the officers arrived, they spoke with the security manager who related that a small bag with a white powdery substance was located on the walkway near the corner of the middle bar and a gambling area. Utilizing the facilities cameras, security was able to observe the bag was dropped by a patron who was still inside. Security recovered the bag and turned it over to the officer and then escorted the officer to view the surveillance footage of the incident. On the footage, the officer observed a white male wearing a white shirt, light colored jeans, and white shoes walking towards the middle bar when he retrieves his cellphone from his rear right pocket. Upon removing the cellphone, a small bag with a white substance is seen falling out of his pocket and then undisturbed until security locates it. The patron/subject, later identified as Georgi Martov, was in the middle bar area. Security escorted officers to Martov and asked about the bag to which Martov initially denied any knowledge but then later admitted it was his. A search of Martov's person resulted in finding a similar bag also containing a white powdery substance in the same pocket the other bag was seen falling out of. Martov was taken into custody and along with the bags, transported to the Des Plaines Police station. Once at the station, the white substance was tested using a Narcotics Identification Kit which was positive for the probable presence of cocaine. Martov was subsequently arrested for one felony count of the Possession of a Controlled Substance. He was cited and released with his court information.

In the passenger side door cup holder, in plain view, was an open alcohol container and the officer detected an odor of cannabis from inside. Both the driver and Quinones were asked to exit the vehicle and a search of the vehicle was conducted. Inside the vehicle, the officer was able to locate drug paraphernalia under the front passenger seat, where Quinones was seated. And a silver in color metal knuckle weapon. Quinones admitted that the items belonged to her when the officer advised her of the violation of the weapon. Quinones was taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where she was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count each of the Unlawful Use of a Weapon and the Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Quinones was cited and released with her court information.

Des Plaines Police responded to a restaurant in the 1500 Block of Rand Road for a suspicious incident in which the caller advised two males were arguing and one left the business without paying for his food. The male was last seen walking south on Des Plaines River Road. Responding officers located a subject walking away from the business followed by an employee and stopped him in the 500 Block. The officer noted the male subject, later identified as Eric Kero, appeared belligerent and uncooperative. As the officers were investigating the incident, Kero made several inappropriate comments towards the employee and officers and when asked for his identification, was unable to provide one. Verbally, Kero stated his name was "Vincent Giacomozzi" but was unable to provide any particulars for the officer. Officers attempted to locate a record for the name provided but was met with negative results due to Kero's false information. Eventually, Kero was positively identified, was taken into custody, and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where he was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Obstructing a Peace Officer. Kero was cited and released with his court information.
