NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS:

OFFENSE: Hit and Run Accident
DATE/TIME: 06/29/2024 6:50 a.m.
LOCATION: Golf Road / East River Road
REPORT #: 24-14925

Both the victim and the Unknown Offender were east on Golf Road approaching the intersection with East River Road traveling in the inside lane. The victim had stopped for the red light near the intersection when the offender failed to reduce speed and struck the rear bumper. The female offender with black hair then fled the area east on Golf Road in a blue vehicle.

The victim and the Unknown Offender were traveling south on Elmhurst Road approaching the I-90 E overpass, the victim in the left lane and the offender in the middle lane. While traveling, the offender drifted into the left lane and struck the passenger side of the victim's vehicle. The offender then fled south on Elmhurst Road towards Touhy Avenue and is described as a gray Mercedes-Benz.

Des Plaines Police had conducted a traffic stop on a Honda CR-V and identified the front seat passenger as Kelley Mendoza. While speaking with Mendoza, the officer noted that there were two open bottles of alcohol on the floor in front of the seat Mendoza was sitting in. The officer asked Mendoza for her information and then ran her through the database. Des Plaines Dispatch alerted the officers that Mendoza had two warrants in her name, one through the Northbrook Police Department and one through the Lake County Sheriff's Police Department. After the warrants were confirmed valid and extraditable, Mendoza was asked to step out of the vehicle and was taken into custody. Mendoza was transported to the Des Plaines Police station where she was subsequently arrested for two counts of the Issuance of a Warrant and turned over to the Northbrook Police Department.

On June 14, 2024, the victim came into the Des Plaines Police station to report a theft that had occurred earlier. The victim stated that he noticed that his Xbox One was missing from his room and when asking his roommates, they indicated that the above subject, Kyla Spaulding, had taken it. The officer attempted to speak with Spaulding about the incident over the phone, but she refused to make any statements. Between June 15 and June 24, the officer learned that the Xbox One had been sold to a pawn shop in Arlington Heights, IL. The officer contacted the shop and learned that the receipt when the item was brought in listed Spaulding as the seller. Contact was made

with Spaulding, and she was asked to come to the station to talk about the incident, to which she did. When Spaulding came in, she was escorted to a secure area of the police station where she was given her Miranda Rights and ultimately admitted to taking the Xbox One. Spaulding was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Theft, was cited and released with her court information.

Des Plaines Police on patrol near Miner Street and Laurel Street observed a black Honda Civic north on Laurel Street accelerate at a high rate of speed. While the officer followed, the Honda went past the stop sign at Perry Street without stopping. The officer then activated his overhead emergency lights and attempted to conduct a traffic stop when the vehicle continued to travel north towards Brown Street. At the intersection, the vehicle again did not stop at the stop sign and without signaling, turned west onto Brown Street and came to a stop near Western Avenue. Prior to the officer being able to stop behind the Honda, it accelerated once more into a parking lot in the 400 Block of Western Avenue and then parked. Due to the actions of the driver not pulling over and abruptly accelerating away from the officer, the driver was immediately detained and identified as the above subject, Noe Munoz. While speaking with Munoz, the officer smelled strongly of alcohol, and he admitted to being at a party but stated he had not drunk prior anything to driving. Munoz' eyes were watery/bloodshot, and he slurred while speaking. Munoz was asked, and consented, to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Upon completion, Munoz showed visible signs of impairment and was taken into custody. After being transported to the Des Plaines Police station, Munoz refused all other tests and questions asked by the officer. Munoz was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Driving Under the Influence; ticketed for Failure to Give Signal when Required, Disregarding a Stop Sign x2, and the Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle. Munoz was cited and released with his court information.
