Des Plaines officers responded to the 700 Block of Algonquin Road for the report of a suspicious person. Officers arrived and observed subject, Devonate Phillips, yelling at residents and appeared highly intoxicated. As officers were speaking to Devonate, he closed distance and attempted to punch an officer. Devonate was placed in handcuffs at this time. Devontae continued yelling and verbally threatening officers. Officers spoke with a victim who stated she and her children were walking in the parking lot and were alarmed by Devontae who was yelling and looking into vehicles. Another victim who was outside with her dog was yelled at by Devontae and ran towards her which alarmed and disturbed her. Devontae was taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police Station where he was subsequently arrested for Criminal Trespass to Property and Disorderly Conduct. Devonate was cited and released from the station with his court information.

On 07/01/2024 Officers responded to the 1500 block of Lee Street for a retail theft. Officers learned that a subject, later identified as Christohper Lawson, was wearing a black ski mask, white long-sleeved shirt, neon yellow vest. Loss prevention employees were made aware of a subject at other locations dressed in the same outfit stealing alcohol from other stores. The employee stated Christopher stole approximately 35 bottles of alcohol from the store at this time. Through the investigation, officers learned other agencies had very similar incidents happen with the same subject and even made contact with him earlier that day. Through security and body camera footage a facial tattoo was noted which is how Christopher was identified. Officers learned Christopher had a court date in Rolling Meadows on the 17<sup>th</sup> when they arrived they took him into custody. The Cook County State's Attorney's Office was contacted and Christopher was subsequently arrested for one felony count of Retail Theft.

On 09/17/2024 Des Plaines officers were notified by the victim that she received an order of protection against Sylwester Ozarowski. The same day, officers served the order to Sylwester who was in the police department lobby after being served the order. Officers were contacted shortly after from the victim stating Sylwester was contacting her being aggressive when he is not supposed to have any contact with her per the order. Sylwester was taken into custody and subsequently arrested for Violation of an Order of Protection.
