Officers were dispatched to Jewel – Osco in reference to a retail theft that occurred on 09/18/2024 at 10:27 AM. The store manager related that a subject entered the store and stole a bottle of liquor. The manager recognized the suspect as Marko Rivera from prior thefts at the store. Officer further reviewed video evidence of the theft confirming that Rivera had committed the Theft. Officers verified that Rivera had also been trespassed from the Jewel on 05/22/2024 and documented the incident in a report. At 9:57 PM, Officers located Rivera on the 1200 Block of East Oakton Street and took him into custody without incident. Rivera was charged with Criminal Trespass to Property and Retail Theft. Rivera was then released on bond.
