On 08/01/24 the complainant made a report at the Des Plaines Police department alleging that her ex-boyfriend Peter Farion had violated an active order of protection in which she was the protected party. On 12/04/2024 at 4:00PM Farion turned himself in at the police station without incident. He was charged with Violation of an Order of Protection and sent to bond hearing at the Skokie courthouse.
