## **NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS:**

OFFENSE: Burglary / Criminal Damage to Property / Fleeing or Attempting to Elude a Peace Officer

/ Failure to Remain at the Scene of a Vehicle Damage Accident

Des Plaines officers responded to the 400 block of W. Touhy Avenue for the report of an attempted motor vehicle theft. An employee stated multiple subjects were standing outside of a vehicle with masks on and he heard glass break. Officers arrived and observed the subjects run into a black Dodge Durango. An officer attempted to stop the subjects from leaving at which time the Durango struck the rear driver's side of the officer's squad car and traveled east on Touhy Avenue at a high rate of speed. Other arriving officers attempted to stop the Durango however they fled the scene while committing multiple traffic violations.
