NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS:

OFFENSE: Criminal Damage to Vehicle
DATE/TIME: 12/25/2024 9:00 p.m. – 12/26/2024 7:00 a.m.
LOCATION: 1800 Block of Bennett Place
REPORT #: 24-30472

The victim's Toyota Venza was parked on the roadway in the 1800 Block of Bennett Place overnight when the Unknown Offender(s) scratched the driver's side doors. The scratches ranged from the front driver's side doors to the rear hatchback and appeared to be from a key.

The BMW proceeded into the parking lot on the northeast corner of Oakton Street and Mount Prospect Road and struck a concrete barrier before coming to a rest. A male offender was seen exiting from the driver's seat wearing all black clothing and an additional male subject was seen exiting the front passenger seat wearing a brown coat. Both fled the area prior to the police arriving.

On December 27, 2024, at 2:39 p.m. Des Plaines Police responded to the report of a motor vehicle accident in the 1700 Block of E. Higgins Road. When the officer arrived, he learned that the two vehicles were west on Higgins Road. The vehicles were a blue Hyundai Sonata traveling in the inside lane and a white Toyota Camry traveling in the outside lane. The Hyundai changed lanes into the outside lane and struck the Toyota in the driver's side. While speaking with the driver of the Hyundai, she mentioned that the driver of the Toyota, later identified as Anthony Colon, admitted to her that he had been drinking. While speaking with Colon, he went to retrieve an item from the closed center console. Upon opening the console, in plain view, was a bottle of alcohol. The officer also detected a strong odor of alcohol emitting from Colon's breath and that his eyes were watery/bloodshot. Colon admitted to consuming alcohol when asked by the officer and that he had been drinking the open bottle of alcohol seen in his vehicle. The officer requested Colon to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, which he agreed, and upon completion showed visible signs of impairment.

Colon was taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where he was also asked to provide a breath alcohol sample. Colon agreed and provided a sample that was twice the legal limit. Colon was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count each of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and DUI with a BAC Over .08;

cited for Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle and Illegal Transportation or Possession of Alcoholic Liquor by a Driver. Colon was cited and released with his court information.

On December 28, 2024, at approximately 4:15 a.m. Des Plaines Police were on patrol in the 900 Block of Graceland Avenue. The officer was southbound on Graceland Avenue when he observed a vehicle that had been involved in an accident. Upon approach of the silver Ford Edge, the subject, Cody Uidl exited the front driver's door to speak with the officer. While investigating the incident he learned that the silver Ford Edge being driven by, was southbound on Graceland Avenue driving at an excessive speed when he lost control and traveled off the roadway. Uidl's vehicle first hit a tree before then striking the victim's vehicle which was parked in a nearby driveway. While speaking with Uidl, the officer detected an odor of alcohol emitting from his breath, his eyes were bloodshot, and his speech was slurred. Uidl also admitted to consuming alcohol prior to driving his vehicle. The officer requested that Uidl perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, which he refused. The officer believed Uidl to be intoxicated and took him into custody.

After being transported to the Des Plaines Police station, Uidl was asked to provide a breath alcohol sample, which he agreed to. The result of said sample was nearly three times the legal limit. Uidl was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count each of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and DUI with a BAC Over .08; cited for Failure to Reduce Speed to Avoid an Accident, Improper Lane Usage, and the Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle. Uidl was cited and released with his court information.

On December 29, 2024, at approximately 4:11 a.m. Des Plaines Police responded to the area of Webster Lane and Howard Avenue for the report of a motor vehicle accident. Cook County Dispatch informed officers that a white sedan had crashed into a residence

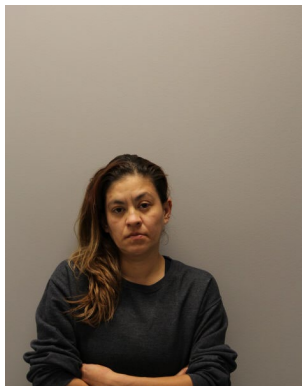

in that area. When the officer arrived in the area, he saw a large amount of damage to a fence in the 900 Block of Howard Avenue but no vehicle still on scene. There also appeared to be damage to the actual home near the fence. Debris left of scene was described as a driver's side mirror and a Honda emblem. It was later learned that the Honda was traveling eastbound on Howard Avenue through the intersection with Webster Lane when it suddenly traveled northeast through the front lawn striking a fence and residence at the above location. The Honda then reversed and was last seen eastbound on Howard Avenue.

As the officer was checking the area he located a white Honda with a large amount of front-end damage near Prospect Avenue and Pine Street. The officer activated his overhead emergency lights and conducted an investigative stop of the Honda. Upon approach of the driver's side, the officer spoke with the subject, Susana Perez, and detected the odor of alcohol emitting from her breath. When asked about the damage, Perez admitted to being in an accident but stated it was the day before and that she was struck by another vehicle. At that time, the officer noted that the Honda was missing the driver's side mirror, consistent with the mirror recovered on scene. During conversation, Perez was slurring her speech however, denied consuming alcohol when asked.

The officer requested Perez to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, to which she complied, and upon completion showed visible signs of impairment. Perez was taken into custody, and a search of his vehicle was conducted yielding a can of alcohol behind the front passenger seat on the floorboard. Perez was transported to the Des Plaines Police station where an additional search of her belongings was conducted. As a result of said search, the officer located a white pill, later identified as Hydrocodone, in her property. The pill was loose on its own and was not located inside a prescribed pill bottle.

Perez was subsequently arrested for one felony count of Possession of a Controlled Substance; one misdemeanor count each of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Leaving the Scene of a Property Damage Accident; cited for Failure to Reduce Speed to Avoid an Accident, Improper Lane Usage, the Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle, and the Illegal Transportation or Possession of Alcoholic Liquor by a Driver. Perez was cited and released with her court information.

Upon arrival, the officer spoke with the above subject, Ravan Hart, and obtained her information which was then run through the database. Cook County Dispatch notified the officer that Hart had a warrant through the Chicago Police Department. CCD confirmed with CPD that the warrant was valid and extraditable when Hart was then taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police station. Hart was subsequently arrested for the Issuance of a Warrant and turned over to the CPD.
