Des Plaines Police responded to the Rivers Casino located in the 3000 Block of S. Des Plaines River Road for the report of an unwanted subject. Security stated that a female, later identified as Audrey Zou, was intoxicated and refusing to leave the property after being told to do so by them. When the officers arrived, they were directed to the east side entrance/taxi boarding area and met with Zou who immediately became verbally confrontational with officers. Security again stated that they had told Zou she had to leave the property however, she was refusing to do so and they wished to pursue a city ordinance citation for trespassing. The officer filled out the ticket and after issuing it to Zou, she still refused to leave. After her consistent refusal, she was taken into custody and using her left leg, kicked the officer while being escorted to the patrol squad. Zou was transported to the Des Plaines Police station where she was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count each of Battery and Criminal Trespass to Real Property in addition to her City Ordinance citation. She was cited and released with her court information.
