NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS:

OFFENSE: Burglary
DATE/TIME: 08/16/2025 3:15 p.m.

The victim's, a 60-year-old male Des Plaines resident, was at home when an Unknown female Offender came to the door and engaged the male in conversation about picking flowers from the side of his house. The male victim escorted the female over to the side and when doing so, two additional Unknown Offenders entered the residence and began rummaging through the home. It was later determined the other two offenders were also female and all three were described as Hispanic. Descriptions of the females were listed as one wearing a purple shirt and black pants of medium build, one heavy set with a purple and black dress, and the other wearing a black shirt. After the offenders fled, the victim noted there were several pieces of missing jewelry and approximately \$30,000 USC.

During the above time frame the Unknown Offender(s) entered the Post Office located in the 600 Block of S. Lee Street and broke the west side windows. An employee stated that there were trash and pamphlets strewn about the rear area of the building and that two windowpanes towards the front of the business were broken out by unknown means.

Des Plaines Police responded to the Des Plaines Public Library in the 1500 Block of Ellinwood Street to check the well-being of a female that entered the library with a small child. When officers arrived, they spoke with the complainant who stated that the female, later identified as Dyeasha Sibley, came into the library with a stroller and child, later identified as a 4-year-old male child, inquiring about bus routes and noted the child was crying. During her time in the library, Sibley entered the elevator with the child twice and both times was seen on surveillance camera striking the child. The complainant then called 9-1-1 while Sibley left the property and walked northbound on Lee Street.

Responding officers located the female subject matching the description near the train station in the 1500 Block of Miner Street. When asked, Sibley admitted to being inside the library, but she had physically had to prevent the child from jumping out of the stroller. The video surveillance was watched from the library and was consistent with the complainants' statements. Sibley was taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where she was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Endangering the Life or Health of a Child and Domestic Battery. She was later brought to a Cook County courthouse for a detention hearing.

Des Plaines Police responded to a residence in the 2400 Block of Ballard Road for the report of a battery that had occurred at 8:31 p.m. When officers arrived, they spoke with the victim, a 74-year-old female Des Plaines resident, who stated that she is in a relationship with the subject, Adam Arnold, and on today's date they got into an argument. During the argument, Arnold pushed her to the ground and hit her with pillows. While the victim called 9-1-1, Arnold fled the residence and was not on scene when officers arrived, however, they spoke to him via telephone where he stated that he had checked into a hotel at an undisclosed location and would come in to talk with officers the following day.

The victim contacted DPPD a second time at 12:02 a.m. stating that Arnold had returned. When officers responded to the residence, they met with Arnold and took him into custody. Arnold was transported to the Des Plaines Police station and subsequently arrested for one count of Domestic Battery. He was later brought to a Cook County courthouse for a detention hearing.

On August 16, 2025, Des Plaines Police responded to the area of Touhy Avenue and Mount Prospect Road for the report of damage to property at 2:15 p.m... The officers met with the victim, a 38-year-old male Des Plaines resident, at a gas station in the 800 Block of E. Touhy Avenue where he stated that while driving on Higgins Road in Elk Grove Village, IL in the inside lane a white Toyota Prius swerved from the curb lane to the inside lane directly in front of the victim and then went into oncoming traffic. As the vehicles continued eastbound, they stopped for a red light at Elmhurst Road and Touhy Avenue where they began to engage in a verbal dispute. The male subject, later identified as the above Ali Nadzhafaliyev, then exited the Toyota and punched the victim's window multiple times and attempted to open the locked door before re-entering his vehicle. Both vehicles continued east and again stopped at a red light at Touhy Avenue and Mount Prospect Road. Nadzhafaliyev was seen taking an aluminum bat and striking the victim's passenger side multiple times before fleeing eastbound on Touhy Avenue when the light turned green.

At that time, the vehicle pulled over and called 9-1-1 to wait for officers. A witness to the incident also stated that they observed the male subject/Nadzhafaliyev hit the victim's vehicle with a bat. The Toyota Prius was further described to be a 303 Taxicab. Officers contacted the company who ultimately provided Nadzhafaliyev's information on August 17. During the first attempts at speaking with Nadzhafaliyev he was unsure if he was in the area during the time of the incident and further denied causing damage to the other vehicle but stated he would come in to speak with officers.

On August 19, Nadzhafaliyev came into the station and refused to give any statements

regarding the incident. He was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Criminal Damage to Property. Nadzhafaliyev was cited and released with his court information.

Des Plaines Police responded to the 2700 Block of Scott Street for the report of a disturbance between two males. When the officers arrived, they located the victim, a 22-year-old male Des Plaines resident, who stated that he is a relative of the above subject, Cristian Correa. The victim had previously lent Correa money and was then refusing to pay it back. The victim then traveled to Correa's residence and once there, Correa came outside and began punching him in the face. Officers observed redness and marks to the victim's face consistent with his statement.

Officers then spoke with Correa who admitted to striking the victim. He was then taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where he was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Domestic Battery. Correa was later brought to a Cook County courthouse for a detention hearing.
