NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS:

OFFENSE: Hit and Run Accident
DATE/TIME: 10/27/2025 11:15 p.m. – 10/28/2025 7:35 a.m.
LOCATION: 300 Block of S. Graceland Avenue
REPORT #: 25-06024

The victim's vehicle was parked on the east side of the roadway in the 300 Block of S. Graceland Avenue overnight when the Unknown Offender(s) struck the driver's side of the vehicle. After the accident, the offender(s) fled the area leaving behind blue scuff marks on the victim's vehicle.

OFFENSE: Hit and Run Accident

LOCATION: Harding Avenue / Alles Street

The victim's vehicle was parked on the north side of Harding Avenue just east of Alles Street during the above time frame when the Unknown Offender(s) struck the driver's side of the vehicle and fled the area. The officer noted that there was blue paint transfer on the victim's vehicle at the point of impact. It is unknown at this time if the above Hit and Run Accident is related.

Des Plaines Police responded to the 1500 Block of Ellinwood Street for a disturbance relating to the above subject, James Turner, possibly violating an order of protection. Officers spoke with the victim who stated that she has an active order against Turner that had been served previously and on today's date, he violated the order. Cook County Dispatch confirmed the order was active and had been served.

Turner was informed of the violation, taken into custody, and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where he was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Violation of an Order of Protection. He was later brought to a Cook County courthouse for a detention hearing.

Please remember that although a person may be charged with a crime, a charge is merely an Accusation, and the person is innocent until proven guilty.
