NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS:

OFFENSE: Hit and Run Accident

The victim's Honda Civic was parked on the roadway in the 200 Block of Dover Lane overnight when the Unknown Offender struck the front of the Honda. Due to the area being a one way, it was suspected that the damage occurred from offender's front passenger side and left white paint transfer before leaving the scene without providing information.

The victim, thinking it was regarding vehicle repairs, went outside to meet him. Once outside the neighbor approached her, hugged her without consent, and licked the inside of her ear, stating in Spanish “did I give you chills” causing her to feel uncomfortable. The suspect, Constantino Martinez-Villegas, denied physical contact, stating he only grabbed the victim’s arm and texted her regarding payment for previous car repairs. After reviewing evidence and speaking with both parties, Constantino was arrested for battery and transported to the Police Dept where he was cited and released with a court date.

On 11/07/2025 at approximately 10:50 p.m., officers responded to the 800 block of E. Touhy Ave. for a disorderly conduct complaint that a male subject burning paper towels outside the store. Witnesses stated the suspect later identified to be Brandon Anderson, started the fire outside the speedway. Officers spoke

to Anderson who admitted to starting the fire to stay warm because no one was coming to pick him up. He further admitted to officers that he had used a lighter to ignite the paper towels. Officers observed burned paper towels and ashes approximately 15 feet from propane tanks and noted damage to a nearby bus shelter bench from an apparent separate fire he had started before going to the Speedway (See 25-06278); Responding Officers used a fire extinguisher to put out the fire near the propane tanks. Brandon was taken into custody and transported to DPPD without incident. He was charged with disorderly conduct, cited, and released with a court date.

On 11/08/2025 at approximately 7:35 p.m., officers responded to the 700 block of Graceland Ave. for a violation of an order of protection. The petitioner reported that Nicholas Swerlyk, who had an active no-contact order, sent messages through Facebook and a group text in an attempt to contact individuals listed on the order of protection, including videos and statements. Officers contacted Nicholas who admitted to sending the messages as described. After officers verified the messages and spoke with Nicholas, officers went to Nicholas' residence in Mt. Prospect and took him into custody without incident. Nicholas was charged with violation of an order of protection and sent to a bond hearing.

Please remember that although a person may be charged with a crime, a charge is merely an Accusation, and the person is innocent until proven guilty.
