NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS:

OFFENSE: Hit and Run Accident
DATE/TIME: 11/14/2025 8:47 a.m.
LOCATION: Des Plaines River Road / Oakton Street

The victim, a 44-year-old male Philadelphia PA resident, was stopped for traffic northbound on Des Plaines River Road approaching the intersection with Oakton Street traveling in the inside lane while the Unknown Offender was also northbound but in the outside lane. Suddenly, the offender turned left in front of the victim causing the victim to strike the offenders rear drivers' side with his front passenger bumper. The offender was described as a white male subject with brown hair driving a Toyota Corolla.

The victim, a 19-year-old male Des Plaines resident, parked his Toyota Camry near the alley at the rear of the property overnight when the Unknown Offender(s) flattened all four tires. Upon further inspection, officers noted that the damage was due to them being punctured by an unknown object.

The male subject brought two bottles of Fabuloso cleaning solution to the counter where he handed the cashier a \$100.00 bill for payment. The clerk ran the bill through a detector which indicated that the bill was fraudulent. After being confronted about the bill, the male offender left the store and was last seen towards Lee Street in a black hat and black pants.


Des Plaines Police were on patrol near Wolf Road and Oakton Street when they observed a black Mercedes-Benz with no rear registration plate traveling west on Oakton Street approaching the intersection. The vehicle and the officer turned north onto Wolf Road where the officer activated his overhead emergency lights and stopped the Mercedes-Benz near Wolf Road and Lincoln Avenue. The officer approached the vehicle and met with the driver, Borislav Borisov, and front passenger, Dinko Kralchev, and informed them the reason for the traffic stop. In response, Borisov stated that he had recently purchased the vehicle from a friend a few hours ago and was on their way to Wisconsin. The title and insurance were requested for the vehicle which Borisov stated he did not have.

The officer requested consent to search the vehicle, which was granted by Borisov. Within the vehicle, the officer located a bottle of alcohol and a small plastic bag with a white powdery substance (suspected to cocaine) in the center console, a large knife tucked between the driver's seat and center console, and a plastic bag containing a green plant like substance (suspected to be marijuana) in the trunk. The officer additionally located a folded paper containing a white powdery substance in the left pocket of Borisov.

Both Borisov and Kralchev were taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police station. Borisov was subsequently arrested for one felony count of Possession of a Controlled Substance; one misdemeanor count of Possession of Adult Use Cannabis in a Motor Vehicle; ticketed for No Valid Registration and the Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle.

Kralchev was subsequently arrested for one felony count of Possession of a Controlled Substance and ticketed for the Illegal Transportation of Alcohol by a Passenger. Both Kralchev and Borisov were cited and released with court information.


OFFENSE: Aggravated Assault / Domestic Battery

Des Plaines Police responded to the 100 Block of King Lane in reference to a domestic disturbance. When the officers arrived, they were met by the caller and also the above subject, Cesar Romero, outside of the residence. Officers interviewed all parties on scene and learned that Romero had threatened the victim, who is a relative, with a knife and had previously hit him in the face. Romero was taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where he was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count each of Aggravated Assault and Domestic Battery. He was later brought to a Cook County courthouse for a detention hearing.

Des Plaines Police were on patrol on Touhy Avenue when a white Chevrolet van was parked facing north at 885 E. Touhy Avenue. The officers noted that they have had several prior incidents with that vehicle and the registered owner, Gregory Kelly, who is known for not having a valid driver's license. After a short while, a male subject, known as Kelly, exited the building on Touhy Avenue, entered the Chevrolet van, and then exited onto Webster Lane. The officer pulled behind the van, noticing that the rear registration plate light was not illuminated, and activated his overhead emergency lights and stopped the vehicle. The officer made contact with Kelly, who was driving the vehicle, and who stated that he did not have a license. Cook County Dispatch ran Kelly's information through the database and confirmed that he did not have a valid license, said license was revoked by the Illinois Secretary of State. The officer requested Kelly exit the vehicle, to which he complied, and later located two cans of alcohol, one of which was half empty and was to the right of the driver's seat. Kelly was taken into custody and transported to the Des Plaines Police station where he was subsequently arrested for one felony count of Driving While Driver's License Revoked; ticketed for No Rear Registration Light, Failure to Wear Seatbelt, Illegal Transportation of Alcohol by a Driver, and the Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle. He was cited and released with his court information.

Des Plaines Police were on patrol in the area of Des Plaines River Road and Rand Road when the officer observed a white Ford van on the roadway conduct a lane usage violation. The officer pulled behind the Ford and activated his overhead emergency lights curbing the vehicle near Perry Street. Upon approach of the driver's side, the officer spoke with the above subject, Jose Marin, who was unable to provide his license but gave the officer his information. A check of Marin's record alerted the officer that he did not have a valid license, and said license was revoked by the Illinois Secretary of State. Marin was advised of the violation, asked to step out of the vehicle, and was taken into custody.

The officer transported Marin to the Des Plaines Police station where he was subsequently arrested for one misdemeanor count of Driving While License Revoked; ticketed for Improper Lane Usage and Display Plate Attachment violation. He was cited and released with his court information.
