OFFENSE: Burglary

Des Plaines officers responded to the 1100-block of North River Road for a burglary to donation boxes. Staff reported that an unknown offender pried open one donation box near the shrine and attempted to pry open a second box near the administration building. Officers observed pry marks on both boxes.
