that he pulled her by her clothing and hair, took her phone, and prevented her from leaving the bedroom. Gustavo stated he drove the family home due to concerns about the victim's intoxication and denied physically attacking her. Gustavo Aparicio was taken into custody and taken to the police station. He was charged with domestic battery and transported to the Cook County courthouse for a detention hearing.
