**OFFENSE:** Criminal Defacement of Property

A Des Plaines Police officer responded to a residence in the 600-block of Murray Lane for a report of criminal damage to property. The building engineer reported that an unknown offender spray-painted approximately 20 feet of an exterior garage wall overnight. Security cameras captured the incident, but the offender could not be identified due to distance and lighting; the individual appeared to be a male wearing dark clothing.
